Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota is nationally recognized as a leader in quality education for its youth; and

WHEREAS: there are many children who require one-to-one tutoring to benefit fully from education offered in the public schools and reach their full potential; and

WHEREAS: public school budgeting cannot possibly provide all of this individual attention that great numbers of children require; and

WHEREAS: WISE (Women in Service to Education) and GISE (Gentlemen in Service to Education) is dedicated to cooperation with the Minneapolis Public Schools to further the efforts of groups and individuals who are interested in supplying volunteer services to the Minneapolis Public Schools; and

WHEREAS: an intensive campaign to inform and recruit volunteers from the public for this special program has been planned for this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 20-25, 1976 as

WISE AND GISE WEEK

in Minnesota and call upon local citizens to give their full support and active participation to this worthwhile project.
