FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

Ennesota and call upon all citizens to initiate a year round campaign against the waste caused seventable fires.

FRMORE, I urge the Chamber of Commerce, business, labor and farm organizations, as well as its, civic groups, and public information agencies, to cooperate in the observance of Fire action Week.
