WHEREAS: the well-being of our citizens depends on the health of our economy; and

WHEREAS: the principle of freedom of enterprise is the basis of our economy and provides the chief impetus for its growth and stability; and

WHEREAS: a better understanding of freedom of enterprise by the people of Minnesota would help to preserve and strengthen our free economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 22 - 28, 1976 as

## FREEDOM OF ENTERPRISE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge our citizens to acquaint themselves with the principles of freedom of enterprise and to avail themselves of the special opportunities provided during this observance by Kiwanis clubs and their 3,800 members throughout the State.
