We, The undersigned, Tom J. Orr, Ike Ykema and John Baas, certify that we are the persons named as Inspectors and Judges of Election in a Resolution dated July 9th, 1925, passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Mille Lacs County and State of Minnesota, and a copy of such Resolution is hereto attached; that we acted as such Inspectors and Judges of Election; that before acting as such we took and subscribed an Oath, which is hereto attached; that previous to said election, on the 9th day of July, 1925, we caused notices of said election, with copies of the petition attached, to be posted in three (3) public places within the territory proposed to be incorporated as the VILLAGE OF PEASE in the Town of Milo, in the County of Mille Lacs and State of Minnesota, as shown by an affidavit of proof of such posting; and

We do further certify, that said election was held at the time and place mentioned in said Resolution, and said Notice of Election, to-wit, from nine (9) o'clock A. M. to five (5) o'clock P. M. on Wednesday, the 1st day of August, 1925, within the territory so proposed to be incorporated, to-wit:

In the Baas Implement Building located on Lot Six (6) of Block One (1) in the Townsite of Pease, according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Mille Lacs and State of Minnesota; and same being situated on the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-seven (27), in Mille Lacs County and State of Minnesota; and same being in the VILLAGE OF PEASE, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, so proposed to be incorporated as a village.

And that we duly counted and canvassed the ballots cast at said election and found that there were 45 votes cast upon the question of said incorporation, of which 43 votes were cast in favor of the proposition, and 2 votes were cast against said incorporation; and that the majority in favor of incorporation was carried by a majority of 41 votes.

NOTIFICATION FOR INCORPORATION

FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF

TO THE INCORPORATING BOARD OF COMMONS COMMISSIONED  
OF THE COUNTY OF MILLE LACS AND STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1st. We, the undersigned, electors and residents upon the land and within the territory hereinafter described and proposed to be incorporated as a village, respectfully petition your Honorable Board to appoint a time and place for holding an election, when and where the electors actually residing upon the lands hereinbefore described may vote for or against the incorporation of the said territory as a village to be known as VILLAGE OF PEACE.

2nd. That the territory to be incorporated as a village is all of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 13, Township 37, Range 27, the North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 13, Township 37, Range 27, the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 13, Township 37, Range 27, the South half of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 13, Township 37, Range 27, and the South half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 13, Township 37, Range 27, all in Mille Lacs County and State of Minnesota, and containing one hundred and forty (140) acres, more or less, according to the Government Survey thereof.


