

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF PAYNE VILLE

TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYMENVILLE, MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, being all of the owners of the territory described below, hereby request the Council to annex this territory to the City and to extend the City boundaries to include the same, and for thes purpose respectfully state:

1. The territory to be annexed consists of approximately three and fifty-seven hundredths (3.57) acres and at the present time has no residents living thereon. That all of these lands lie entirely within the County of Stearns, state of Minnesota. That the description of such lands is as follows:

All that part of the South seventy-one (71) rods of the West twenty-two end one-half (22 1/2) rods of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section Numbered Sixteen (16) in Township Numbered Cne Hundred Twenty-two (122) North of Range Numbered Thirty-two (32) West lying and being Southerly of Minnesota Trunk Highway Number 55 as now constructed and constituted. Containing 3.57 acres.

- 2. The territory described above is surrounded by the city limits of the City of Paynesville and none of it is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated City, Village or Borrough.
- 3. All of this territory is or is about to become residential in character, the undersigned intending to put upon said premises residential or commercial buildings and plat a subdivision.

That public utilities are necessary for this development and that there is immediately adjacent to and available to the property water service and that centery newage lines could be made available to the same, and that the Petition is made in reliance upon the City having indicated that they are willing to extend the necessary utilities to said property.

CRDINANCE NO. 5 - 1976 ORDINANCE TO ANNEX OFFICIAL PROPERTY ADJOINING

THE CITY OF PAYNESVILLE

WHERFAS, derived territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated dist, village or borrough; and WHERFAS, this territory borders upon the city limits of the City of Fayacoville and is decreed to be residential in character; and
