ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SPICER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Spicer, a municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota, by the property owner having the sole interest therein, to have certain real property hereinafter described included in the limits of the City of Spicer, and;

WHEREAS, it is proposed to annex by virtue hereof to said City of Spicer, said property all of which property is in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and;

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed consists of approximately 4.39 acres more or less, described as follows, to wit:

All that part of Government Lot 1 of Section 4, Township 120, Range 34 described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast Corner of said Government Lot 1; thence on an assumed bearing of West, along the South line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 425.00 feet; thence on a bearing of North one degree, 29 minutes, West, Parallel to the East line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 450.00 feet; thence on a bearing of East, 425.00 feet to the East line of said Government Lot 1; thence on a bearing of South one degree, 29 minutes, East, along the East line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 450.00 feet to the point of beginning.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Spicer hereby determines, ordains, and declares as follows:

I.

That the annexation would be in the best interest of the City of Spicer, Minnesota and to the best interest of the property affected.

II.

That the property above-described butts on the city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City Government.

III.

That the property is hereby annexed to and included within, the City of Spicer, Minnesota as effectually as if it has originally been a part hereof.

IV.

That this Ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the

Minnesota Municipal Commission, Green Lake Town Clerk, Kandiyohi County Auditor, and the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, from and after its passage and publication.
