ORDINANCE NO. 18.02

ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF ELK RIVER

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELK RIVER ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the following described real estate situated in the County of Sherburne, State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

The South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S½ of NW¼) lying West of the State Trunk Highway formerly known as the Elk River - Princeton Road and now described as Minnesota Highway No. 201 except the West 10 rods of the North 4 rods thereof, being the Catholic Cemetery, Section 27, Township 33, Range 26.

That part of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter (N½ of SW¼) lying West of the State Highway formerly known as the Elk River-Princeton road now designated as Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 201, except about One (1) acre in the Northeast corner being the Catholic Cemetery, which is described in Book W of Deeds, page 116, and Book 77 of Deeds, page 601, in the office of the Sherburne County Register of Deeds is also described as follows: Beginning at a point where the West line of the right-of-way of said Trunk Highway No. 169 intersects the East and West Quarter Line of said Section Twenty-seven (27) using said Quarter Line as established in Survey No. 579, page 17, of Book "C" of Survey Records; thence West on said Quarter Line a distance of 224.20 feet; thence South at right angles to saidQuarter line a distance of 262 feet; thence East at right angles and parallel with said Quarter Line a distance of 117.2 feet to the West line of the right-of-way of said Trunk Highway No. 169; thence Northeasterly along the West line of said right-of-way a distance of 282.50 feet to the point of beginning.

The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE¼ of NE¼) of Section 28, Township 33, Range 26, except that part thereof described as follows: The North 520 feet of the West 800 feet thereof,

is hereby annexed to the Village of Elk River, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 414.033, Subdivision 5, of the Minnesota Statutes Annotated.

Section 2. Passed July 2, 1973. Effective upon compliance with Chapter 414.033, Subdivision 7, of the Minnesota Statutes Annotated.
