ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND TO THE CITY OF LITTLEFORK

WHEREAS, a petition has been duly filed pursuant to Sec. 414.033 M.S.A. to have the real estate hereinafter described annexed to the City of Littlefork, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, said petition was signed by all of the owners of said real estate and duly filed with the City Council of the City of Littlefork, Minnesota; the Koochiching County, Minnesota, Board of County Commissioners; and the Minnesota Municipal Commission; and said real estate is unincorporated land abutting the City of Littlefork, is not included in any other municipality, does not abut or border on any town, organized township or other municipality, and is unplatted (although in the process of being platted) and does not exceed 200 acres; and

WHEREAS, more than 60 days have elapsed since the filing of said petition and no objections to such annexation having been submitted to the Minnesota Municipal Commission or the City of Littlefork;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Littlefork, Minnesota, ordains:

1. That the annexation of the hereinafter described real estate is in the best interests of the City of Littlefork and of the territory affected.

2. That the property described as follows: A tract of land lying in the County of Koochiching and State of Minnesota described as follows, to-wit: That part of Government Lot 13, Section 4, Township 68 North, Range 25 West, described as follows: Starting at a point on the south line and 33 feet West of the southeast corner of Section 4, thence north parallel to east line of Section 4 a distance of 528 feet, thence north 90° west a distance of 670 feet, more or less, to the east bank of the Littlefork River, thence south-southwesterly along said east bank of Littlefork River to the south line of section 4, thence east along south line of Section 4 a distance of 730 feet, more or less, to point of beginning, said parcel containing 8.32 acres, be and the same hereby is annexed to the City of Littlefork, Minnesota.

3. This ordinance shall be effective and final upon its passage and publication and upon filing of a copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Koochiching County Auditor, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.
