

EPEAS: Fay Frawley then further distinguished himself as Football Line Coach at De La Salle High School from 1946-1950 and from 1952-1958, and as head coach in 1956-1958; and

ETTEAS: he has been an eminent and highly respected spokesperson on behalf of the interests and concerns of the men and women of labor serving as the secretary-treasurer of the Bartenders Union, Local 152, as Secretary of Hotel and Restaurant Employees, Local 17 and as vice president of the Executive Board of the Minnesota AFL-CIO; and

EREAS: another longtime interest of Fay Frawley's is the sport of boxing and in 1962, he was appointed to the Boxing Commission by Gov. Karl Rolvaag and to the Board of Directors of Upper Midwest Golden Gloves in 1966, on which he still serves; and

EREAS: his longtime efforts in support of key DFL candidates and causes has been invaluable to the fortunes of the Minnesota Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party, both literally and figuratively and

TEREAS: he has been a dedicated civic leader and churchman, a loving husband to the former Kathleen Pearson, a devoted father and grandfather;
