An unsurveyed Island located in the central portion of the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 63 North, Range 14 West, 4th P.M., lying approximately 22 chains West and 6 chains North of the S.E. corner of said Section, and 2.5 chains West from the S.W. shore line of Lot 10 of Sec. 12-63-14, containing approximately 0.15 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
