WHEREAS: *the Bicentennial of our nation's founding is a time to celebrate the birth of our great democracy; and*

WHEREAS: *the Bicentennial of our nation's founding is also a time when communities throughout our land can make lasting contributions to our nation's third century; and*

WHEREAS: *Richville will hold a special community Bicentennial celebration on August 22, 1976; and*

WHEREAS: *as its own contribution commemorating the start of the third century in Minnesota, and as a tribute to all that has gone before, Richville will open its Bicentennial Museum on August 22, 1976;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, August 22, 1976 as

RICHVILLE BICENTENNIAL DAY

in Minnesota, and send warmest greetings and best wishes to the citizens of the Richville community.
