WHEREAS: the hearing-impaired population of Minnesota numbering 125,000 is deserving of greater

recognition and in need of new avenues of cultural expression; and

WHEREAS: a great need for leadership exists in developing the potentials of the hearing-impaired;

and

WHEREAS: great benefit can accrue from such development to both the hearing-impaired and those

who hear;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 27, 1976 as

MINNESOTA THEATRE OF THE DEAF DAY

and extend best wishes for success in the future.
