WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Theatre Institute of the Deaf is announcing its official opening in conjunction with the issuance of this proclamation; and*

WHEREAS: *the hearing-impaired population of Minnesota numbering 125,000 is deserving of greater recognition and in need of new avenues of cultural expression; and*

WHEREAS: *a great need for leadership exists in developing the potentials of the hearing-impaired; and*

WHEREAS: *great benefit can accrue from such development to both the hearing-impaired and those who hear;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 27, 1976 as
