WHEREAS: transportation is America's lifeline to the social, economic, and environmental well-being of its people and institutions; and

WHEREAS: highways are an essential artery in the transportation lifeline, serving the needs of all the people; and

WHEREAS: all modes of transportation presently in use and planned for the future constitute the basic framework for continuing progress; and

WHEREAS: the week of September 19-25, 1976 has been designated and will be observed as National Highway and Transportation Week throughout all 50 states;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 19-25, 1976 as

HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe the week in proper recognition of the extreme importance the role of "Transportation America's Lifeline" plays in the continued improvement and maintenance of the good life enjoyed by citizens of the State of Minnesota.
