Resolution REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO HAVE CENSUS OF
THE CITY OF EVELETH TAKEN

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eveleth:

THAT WHEREAS, the amount of the taxes that may be levied by or for any City or Village for any and all general and special purposes whatsoever, exclusive of taxes levied for special assessments for local improvements upon property specially benefited thereby is limited by the provisions of Chapter 417 of the Session Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1921 to One Hundred Dollars per capita of the population of such city or village.

And Whereas it is also provided in said Chapter 417 Session Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1921, that in any year in which no State or Federal census is taken pursuant to law in such city or village, a census of the population of such city or village may be taken, by the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, upon the city council or other governing body of such city or village passing a resolution requesting such census and furnishing a certified copy of said resolution to said Secretary of State

And Whereas no State or Federal census has been taken in the City of Eveleth during the present calendar year,

AND WHEREAS it is the opinion of this Council that said census should be taken, in view of the fact that there has been recently ~~been~~ annexed and added to the city of Eveleth a large territory containing a numerous population, and that said census will be to the advantage of the City of Eveleth

NOT THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eveleth that the Hon. Mike Holm, Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota be and he hereby is requested to immediately take a census of the population of the City of Eveleth, and that upon completion of said census the same be certified to this City Council, and that the expense of said census be paid by the City of Eveleth, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to forthwith furnish said Secretary of State with a certified copy of this resolution.


