WHEREAS: Minnesota encourages the active participation of the blind in athletic and physical fitness programs and endeavors; and

WHEREAS: The National Beep Baseball Association has greatly contributed to the physical and mental discipline of blind athletes; and

WHEREAS: The National Beep Baseball Association is sponsoring a tournament at Dunning Stadium in St. Paul, September 10-12, 1976; and

WHEREAS: the Association has especially benefitted the eight teams who will be playing the 1976 National Beep Baseball Tournament;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim September 6 - 13, 1976 as

NATIONAL BEEP BASEBALL WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to attend and support the National Beep Baseball Tournament and to witness the attained skills and accomplishments of these unsighted athletes.
