WHEREAS: *the National Safety Town Center is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the importance of preschool and early childhood safety education; and*

WHEREAS: *the Safety Town program objectives are: to introduce the importance of safety awareness to our young people; to allow our teenagers, who serve as volunteer instructors, the opportunity to further their knowledge and awareness about children and safety; to include parents in classes with their children to better understand their children's physical and mental development as it relates to safety capabilities; to encourage "community involvement" by providing business, industry, organizations, city and school officials, an opportunity to work together in organizing and conducting this extremely important program for their community; and*

WHEREAS: *the safety of our most precious resource...our children...is of great concern to everyone; and*

WHEREAS: *the National Safety Town Center of Cleveland, Ohio is sponsoring a National Safety Town Week;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 19 - 25, 1976 as

in Minnesota and call upon our citizens to join in this important program to promote Safety Town throughout the state.
