WHEREAS: the conference "NASSU PRESENTS, A LEARNING EXPERIENCE" offers excellent educational opportunities for the small system data processing user;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 26, 1976 as
