

The following resolution was offered by Director Webb:

WHEREAS, it appears that the population of Independent School District Number Eighteen, Saint Louis County, Minnesota is much in excess of the figures as shown in last regular census and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the administration of the affairs of the schools in said district to levy a tax commensurate with the actual population of the district,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; That the School Board of Independent School District Number Eighteen, Saint Louis County, Minnesota make application to the Secretary of State, of the State of Minnesota, to have a census of said District taken in the manner prescribed by the statutes.

Director Webb moved that the above resolution be adopted and Director Rutherford supported the motion. Chairman Fulton then put the motion and it was adopted by the following vote:

Ayes--Johnson, Rutherford, Webb, Gosgrove, Fulton.

Nays--None.

Director Walstrom was absent.
