SECTION 2. FEARITHMY ANNIAND. The corporate limits of the
City of Common Fells are hereby extended to include the unplatted
land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and
included within the City of Common Falls as effectually as if it
had originally been a part thereof:

Parts of the west half (WA) of the Northwest Quarter (NWA) of Section 17, in Township 112 North, of Range 17 West of the fifth principal meridian, in the County of Goodhuc and State of Minnesota, Rescribed as follows:

Commencing at a point where the south line of Minnesota Street in the City of Cannon Falls intersects with the west line of said Section 17, running thence North on the section line to the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Cuarter (NVI) of said Section 17, thence East 1012 feet, thence South to a point due East of the point of beginning, thence due west to the point of beginning.

Also, from a point where the South line of Minnesota Street in the City of Camon Falls intersects with the West line of said Section 17, run due East 225 feet for the point of beginning of tract to be described, running thence due East 105 feet, thence South to the centerline of Mighway No. 19, thence Westerly along the highway centerline to a point due South of the point of beginning, thence due North to the point of beginning.

Also beginning at a point 1012 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Northwest Cuarter (NWM) of said Section 17; thence continuing East to the Northeast corner of said Northwest Cuarter (NWM) of Section 17; thence South 402 feet; thence Southwesterly to a point 106 feet West of the East line of the Northwest Cuarter (NWM) and 602 feet South of the Northwest Cuarter (NWM) and 602 feet South of the North line of said Section 17; thence South 115 feet to a point 603 feet North of the South line of the North One-Half of the Northwest Cuarter (NMM) of said Section 17; thence West 726 feet; thence South to the centerline of Minnesota State Highway No. 19; thence Westerly along centerline of said Highway No. 19 to a point 1230 feet East of the West line of said Section 17; thence North 460 feet; thence West 120 feet; thence South approximately 455 feet to the centerline of said Highway No. 19; thence West 50 feet along the centerline of Highway No. 19; thence North 359.5 feet; thence West 48 feet to a point 1012 feet East of the West line of said Section 17; thence North to the point of beginning. Goodhue County, Minnesota.
