IN THE PREPARATION OF THE VILLAGE OF PEACE, MILLE LACS COUNTY, MINNESOTA, FROM THE TOWN OF HILLO IN SAID COUNTY OF MILLE LACS AND STATE OF MINNESOTA AS A SEPARATE ELECTORAL AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT.

TO THE HONORABLE PRESIDENT AND COUNCILS OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL  
OF THE VILLAGE OF PEACE, MILLE LACS COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

WE, the undersigned, Judges and Clerk of Election, do hereby certify, that we acted as Judges and Clerk of Election, and that before acting as such, we each took and subscribed an oath, which is hereto attached; and

WE do further certify, that said election was held at the time and place mentioned in the Notice of Election, to-wit, from nine (9) o'clock A. M. to five (5) o'clock P. M. on Wednesday, the 29th day of August, 1923, in the Village of Peace, to-wit;

In the Baas Implement Building located on Lot Six (6) in Block One (1) of the Townsite of Peace, according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Milles Lacs and State of Minnesota; same being situated on the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (SE<sup>1/4</sup> of SW<sup>1/4</sup>) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-seven (27), in Milles Lacs County and State of Minnesota;

And that we duly counted and canvassed the votes cast at said election and found there were 28 votes cast upon the question of separating the Village of Peace from the Town of Hillo in the County of Milles Lacs and State of Minnesota, and to constitute the said Village of Peace as a separate Election and Assessment District, of which 28 votes were cast in favor of said separation and no votes were cast against said separation, and that the majority in favor of separation was carried by a majority of 28 votes.


