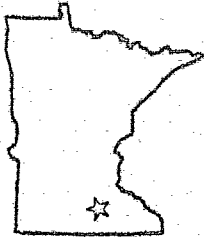

ORDINANCE NO. 6, SECOND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAINT PETER TO INCLUDE THE CITY AIRPORT PROPERTY CONSISTING OF 116 ACRES OF LAND LOCATED IN SECTIONS EIGHT (8) AND FIVE (5) IN TOWNSHIP ONE HUNDRED TEN (110) NORTH, RANGE TWENTY-SIX (26) WEST.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PETER ORDAINS:

Section 1: The following tract of land, City Airport property, consisting of 116 acres of land, unincorporated and unplatted, abutting on the City of St. Peter, is owned by the City of St. Peter, is hereby declared by the City Council to be annexed to the City and pursuant to Minn. Stats. 414.033, said land is deemed to be urban in character. The tract of land is described as follows:

The South Half of the Northeast Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eight (8), Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West and the East 595 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Five (5), Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West, subject to highway easements of record; excepting therefrom the following tract of land, to-wit: The West 725 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eight (8), Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West.

Section 2: The annexation will be to the best interests of the City of St. Peter.

Section 3: The corporate limits of the City of St. Peter are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed and included within the City as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4: All the provisions of Chapter 1 of the St. Peter City Code are made a part hereof and applicable to this Ordinance.

Section 5: The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Nicollet County Auditor and the Traverse Township Clerk.

Adopted by the City Council this 14th day of July, 1975.
