ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of Thief River Falls ordains:

Section 1. Whereas the sole owner of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

A parcel of land which is part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T.154N., R.43 W. bounded as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Thirteenth Street and the Easterly Right-of-Way of the Burlington Northern Railroad; thence N 05° 35' 30" W along said Railway line to an intersection with the North line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence N. 88° 29' 30" E along said one-quarter line a distance of 459.934 feet; thence S 00° 50' 15" W to an intersection with the centerline of Thirteenth Street; thence Westerly along said centerline to the point of beginning; containing 11.5 acres more or less,

has petitioned to the City Council to have such land included within the City Limits of the City of Thief River Falls and has filed copies of said Petition with the Municipal Board of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of the Township of North of the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota and with the County Board of the County of Pennington, State of Minnesota, and

Whereas the above described property abuts upon the boundaries of the City of Thief River Falls and

Whereas no objections to the proposed annexation have been submitted,

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby determined that the annexation of said premises will be to the best interests of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of North Township, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
