WHEREAS: the many Amateur Radio operators in the great State of Minnesota, and in this Bicentennial year of our great nation, stand ready to aid and assist government and law enforcement agencies in the time of natural disasters and public emergencies; and

WHEREAS: those Amateurs donate their time and equipment and educate themselves in the fascinating art of radio-electronics, and at the same time devote themselves to the service of the general public; and

WHEREAS: the initiative and resourcefulness of these many radio operators have been demonstrated many times;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 27 through October 3, 1976 as

AMATEUR RADIO WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to give proper attention and credit to the men and women engaged in this important and essential communications program.
