

Proclamation

WHEREAS: more than 20,000 young people in Minnesota are newspaper carriers; and

WHEREAS: these young people show extraordinary ambition and willingness to accept responsibility and

WHEREAS: newspaper carriers operate as independent contractors to the state's newspapers, thereby learning how to operate a small business as well as how to deal with people; and

WHEREAS: newspaper carriers provide a service which makes news easily available to the public;

WHEREAS: this effort helps to promote freedom of the press; and

WHEREAS: each year a special day is set aside to recognize the efforts, initiative, creativity and dedication of newspaper carriers throughout Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, October 16, 1976 to be

NEWSPAPER CARRIER DAY

in Minnesota.
