



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees and Mrs. Jaycees are non-profit organizations dedicated to the betterment of all mankind; and

WHEREAS: Multiple Sclerosis is a disease which attacks the central nervous system of approximately 500,000 Americans; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has the second highest incidence rate of Multiple Sclerosis in the nation; and

WHEREAS: Multiple Sclerosis attacks men and women of Jaycee and Mrs. Jaycee age; and

WHEREAS: there is no definite known cause or cure for Multiple Sclerosis; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees and Mrs. Jaycees have designated the week of January 8 - 16, 1977 as "Jaycees and Mrs. Jaycees Strike Out M.S. Week" in Minnesota to raise funds to aid the fight against Multiple Sclerosis.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 8 - 16, 1977 as

"JAYCEES AND MRS. JAYCEES STRIKE OUT M.S. WEEK"

in Minnesota and call upon our citizens to join the Jaycees and Mrs. Jaycees to aid the Multiple Sclerosis cause.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
