WHEREAS: Alpha Delta Kappa, an organization of over 1,000 educators in our state, is composed of individuals who made countless contributions to the heritage of our state; and

WHEREAS: Alpha Delta Kappa was organized in 1947 and has since grown to be international, as well as national, in scope; and

WHEREAS: the 40 Alpha Delta Kappa Chapters in Minnesota have carried out several worthwhile programs, including scholarships, aid to needy teachers, programs for educational advancement, and other civic and philanthropic activities; and

WHEREAS: the goals of Alpha Delta Kappa -- promoting high standards of education and contributing to world understanding, goodwill and peace helps to strengthen our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 10 - 16, 1976 as
