WHEREAS: thousands of residents in the State of Minnesota participate in this hobby; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Aquarium Society is a non-profit organization dedicated to the study, breeding, spawning and exhibition of all aquatic life; and

WHEREAS: they are participating in a tribute to our nation's bicentennial entitled "Aquarium Extravaganza '76" which will display all types of aquatic life including tropical fish, reptiles, amphibians and terrariums; and

WHEREAS: the largest tropical fish exhibition in the Upper Midwest will be held September 21-26, 1976 at Rosedale Center, St. Paul;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 20-26, 1976 as
