WHEREAS: Dr. Leon C. Snyder has played a significant role in the development of hardy ornamentals for landscaping in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: he has been the driving force behind the growth and expansion of the University of Minnesota Landscape Arboretum which is devoted to testing and developing hardy ornamentals; and

WHEREAS: he has served as the Head of the Department of Horticultural Science, the Superintendent of the Horticultural Research Center, and the Director of the Landscape Arboretum while at the University of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: the people of Minnesota and the entire horticultural industry have been greatly benefitted and rewarded by his efforts; and
