

# Proclamation

REASONS: December 7, 1976 marks the 35th anniversary of Pearl Harbor; and

REASONS: December 7 recalls a day that Americans will never forget and whose significance must be taught to our youth; and

REASONS: the Pearl Harbor survivors stand as a living testimony of our continuing obligation to be prepared to defend ourselves;

WHEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 7, 1976 as

## PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY

Minnesota, and urge attention to the proper commemoration of this event in American history, and the honor to the defenses of Pearl Harbor.
