WHEREAS: production and inventory control management is an important adjunct to any industry as it exercises continuous control over all phases of material flow both into and out of each manufacturing establishment; and

WHEREAS: production and inventory control management enables manufacturers to establish well-ordered working relationships with producers and distributors of their own products; and

WHEREAS: The American Production and Inventory Control Society Incorporated was organized in 1957 and now has a membership of over 16,000 members in 150 Chapters through the United States, one territory, and ten international affiliates; and

WHEREAS: the primary objectives of this international professional society are to develop professional efficiency in production and inventory management through study, research, and application of scientific methods and thereby advance the general welfare of the industrial economy; and

WHEREAS: the week of October 18 - 22, 1976 has been designated as National American Production and Inventory Control Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 18 - 22, 1976 to be
