



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: Frank J. Kucera, M.D. was born on September 24, 1894 in Hutchinson Township, McCloud County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: both of his parents were born in Czechoslovakia, his mother's family being early residents of Hopkins; and

WHEREAS: he takes pride in his Czech heritage and was a member of the scholarly Kaminsky Society while a student at the University of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: he graduated from the University of Minnesota Medical School in 1921 and has practiced this honorable profession for 55 years; and

WHEREAS: during his long medical practice in Hopkins, from which he is about to retire, he was a school board member for 27 years and a member of the Boy Scout Council for seven years; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kucera has always participated in Czech activities and has belonged to the Sokol for more than 50 years; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kucera has been named Hopkins' Outstanding Czechoslovakian Citizen for 1976;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, October 16, 1976 to be

in Minnesota.
