this honorable profession for 55 years; and

WHEREAS: during his long medical practice in Hopkins, from which he is about to retire, he was

a school board member for 27 years and a member of the Boy Scout Council for seven

years; and

CHEREAS: Dr. Kucera has always participated in Czech activities and has belonged to the Sokol

for more than 50 years; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kucera has been named Hopkins' Outstanding Czechoslovakian Citizen for 1976;
