THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: SECTION 1-

That the City of Minneapolis does hereby accept and become subject to An Act and all the provisions of An Act passed by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota at its session in 1893, entitled "An Act to grant additional powers to the Cities of the State of Minnesota, and to empower such Cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned", approved April 12, 1893; and that the City of Minneapolis shall hereafter be subject to the provisions of said Act, and shall be governed, controlled and regulated by and under the provisions of said Act. SECTION 2-

That upon the passage of this Ordinance by a threefourths vote of all the members-elect of the City Council and the approval and publication thereof, as provided by the Charter of the City of Minneapolis, the City Clerk shall forward to and file in the office of the Secretary of State, a certified copy of this Ordinance so approved and duly certified, accompanied by a statement of the vote of the City Council thereon with the names of the members voting for and against this Ordinance. SECTION 3-

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication PASSED- June 9th, 1893
