

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND PURSUANT TO M.S.A. 414.033

The council of the Village of Plato, Minnesota, having considered the petition of Alfred Kephart to annex certain land, and notice having been given as required by statute, with no objections thereto having been submitted, and it having been determined that said annexation is in the best interests of the municipality and of the territory affected, does hereby ordain:

1. That the following described property is hereby annexed to the Village of Plato:

All that part of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 115, Range 27, McLeod County, Minnesota, lying South of the Southerly right of way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company, and lying North of the Norhterly right of way line of U. S. Highway No. 212.

2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
