### ORDINANCE NO. 43-C SECOND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLAITED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a petition has been received, requesting annexation to the City of Hastings of the property described in said petition, which petition was filed:

By Raymond L. Nowicki regarding the West one-half of the Northwest Quarter (Wi of NWi) of Section Four, Township 114, Range 17, Dakota County, Minnesota, together with that part of the East half of said Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 114, Range 17, described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said East half of the Northwest Quarter; thence East along the South line thereof, a distance of 382.86 feet; thence Northeasterly to a point on the North line end 60 feet West of the Northeast corner of said East half of the Northwest Quarter; thence West to the Northwest corner thereof; thence South to the point of beginning, containing an area of approximately 126.78 acres, more or less, according to Government Survey.

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within said petition is less than 200 acres, unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the sole owner of the property; and

WHEREAS, no objection to the annexation has been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Board according to advices from the Minnesota Municipal Board, nor has an objection to the annexation been received by the City of Hastings from the Town Board or the governing body of any other municipality; and

WHEREAS, said parcel abuts upon the southerly limits of the City of Hastings;

NOW, THEREFORE:

The City Council of the City of Hastings in Dakota County, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the manexation will be to the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described in the petition abuts upon the

city limits of the City of Hastings, and is about to become urban or suburban in character; (3) that none of said property is now included within the limits of any city or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Hastings is hereby extended to include unplatted lands described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to include within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The West one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 114, Range 17, Dakota County, Minnesota, together with that part of the East half of said Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 114, Range 17, described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said East half of the Northwest Quarter; thence East along the South line thereof, a distance of 382.86 feet; thence Northeasterly to a point on the North line and 60 feet West of the Northeast corner of said East half of the Northwest Quarter; thence West to the Northwest corner thereof; thence South to the point of beginning, containing an area of approximately 126.78 acres, more or less, according to Government Survey.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk of Marshan Township and the County Auditor of Dakota County.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copy as directed in Section 3.
