

ORDINANCE - 76-2

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNEXATION

THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That DuWayne W. Galow and Karen Galow, the sole owners of property described in this Ordinance, have petitioned the City of Granite Falls for annexation of the described property to the City of Granite Falls.

That the described land is unplatted, does not exceed 200 acres, that more than 60 days have passed since filing of the petition of annexation, and that no objections have been received.

The City Council of the City of Granite Falls having determined that the annexation will be to the best interest of the municipality and of the territory affected, the following described land situated in the County of Chippewa, State of Minnesota, is declared annexed to the City of Granite Falls:

A tract of land beginning at the South Quarter Corner of Section Twenty-Seven (27), Township One Hundred Sixteen (116), Range Thirty-Nine (39); thence North Five Hundred Sixty-Five (565) Feet; thence East Six Hundred Ninety-Four (694) Feet; thence South Five Hundred Sixty-Five (565) Feet; thence West Six Hundred Ninety-Four (694) Feet to the place of beginning, said beginning also known as the Southwest Corner of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), said tract containing Nine (9) acres, more or less.
