Be it further resolved that T.A.Haugen, Nels R.Oien and Peter Tuff, be and they hereby are appointed as inspectors to act as Judges at said ~~maxim~~ election.

TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF KITTSON COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Come now the undersigned petitioners and respectfully represent that the said petitioners are voters residing upon the land hereinafter mentioned and described being the same proposed to be incorporated as a village under the laws of the State of Minnesota.

That the town-site of Halm, in the County of Kittson and State of Minnesota is included within the said land so proposed to be incorporated;

That the said town-site of Halm has been platted into lots and blocks and said plat has been duly and legally certified according to the law of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County.

And the said petitioners further represent that the said land proposed to be incorporated as a village under the laws of this State are as follows, viz:

The Southwest quarter (SW¹) of section twenty one (21) The South half of Southeast quarter (S₁) of section Twenty one (21) The North half of Northwest quarter (N₁) of secⁿ 21 and the North half of Northeast quarter (N₂) of secⁿ 21 and the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter (SW₂) of secⁿ 21 of section twenty seven (27) The Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter (NW₁) of secⁿ 29 of Section twenty nine (29) The East half of Southeast quarter (E₁) of secⁿ 20 all in Township one hundred sixty (160) North of Range forty six (46) West of the 5th. P.M. Containing 300 acres less the 300 rods right-of-way be the same more or less according to the Government Survey thereof. And that the name of said village proposed to be incorporated is "HALM" and that the number of persons now actually residing in the territory proposed to be incorporated is 118 and that a day not more than eight weeks previous to the day when this petition is presented to the County Board, to-wit: On the 6th. day of August 1923 an accurate census was taken by your petitioners and under their direction of the residents population of said lands and district proposed to be incorporated as the said population was on the said day the census was so taken and that the number of persons in said territory as so ascertained is the sum of 118.

WHEREFORE, Your petitioners pray your honorable body that the said lands and district above described and the whole thereof be incorporated as a village under the laws of the State of Minnesota; And that the name of the village be "HALM" and that at such a time and place be appointed when and where the voters actually residing within said territory may vote for or against said proposed incorporation.




