SPECIAL ATTORNEY APPOINTMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and upon the written request of the Department of Human Rights (a copy of which is attached), do hereby constitute and appoint

KATHLEEN M. GRAHAM

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Attorney for the purpose of providing legal services to the Department of Human Rights in the matters entitled Mapis and Zander v. Burnsville Bowl; Brown v. Minnesota-Wisconsin Truck Lines; Schissel v. Independent School District No. 308; Sattelal v. Reynolds; Burrus v. Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing Company, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. This appointment shall be effective October 18, 1976, and is subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

1. REPORTS. The Special Attorney shall submit a monthly report setting forth in detail her activities regarding this appointment.
2. COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. As compensation for satisfactory performance of the duties herein described, the Special Attorney shall be compensated on a \$30.00 per hour basis. The Special Attorney shall be reimbursed for travel expenses in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the State of Minnesota, Commissioner of Administration governing the travel of state officers and employees. All compensation and expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated to the Department of Human Rights.
3. STATUS. The Special Attorney shall not be considered a state employee, shall not be eligible for the state's life insurance or basic health benefits coverage and shall not accrue vacation or sick leave or any benefits other than those expressly provided herein.

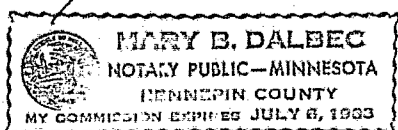

Re: Appointment of Special Attorneys for EEOC Litigation Pilot Program


Dear Warren:
