


State of Minnesota



Proclamation

WHEREAS: through REACT (Radio Emergency Associated Citizens Teams), over 100,000 Americans participate as volunteers to provide highway safety and emergency communications using their own CB radios in their local communities; and

WHEREAS: their cumulative effort, totaling over 21-million volunteer man-hours this year, saves many American lives annually, through the greater speed with which medical aid is reached to an accident scene, and better communications provided in time of natural disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the month of November, 1976 as

NATIONAL REACT MONTH

in Minnesota, during which all citizens shall take notice and be aware of the significant contribution every local REACT team makes to the welfare of their local community, and the nation as a whole. National REACT Month shall be dedicated as time to honor and recognize these local citizens groups and their individual members.
