



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has participated in the nationwide celebration of the 200th birthday of these United States; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota wishes to foster historic events during this Bicentennial Year;

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota recognizes the tremendous growth of transportation during the past 200 years; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Legislature is recognized as a leader in providing laws to promote and protect the citizenry of this State; and

WHEREAS: in the pursuit of that goal, the Minnesota Legislature has mandated by law the creation of the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota recognizes a statewide balanced transportation plan is vital to the social, economic and environmental well-being of all its people and their institutions; and

WHEREAS: this day of November 8, 1976, has been designated as the first day of the Minnesota Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 8, 1976 as

MINNESOTA TRANSPORTATION DAY

and call upon all citizens to recognize the existence of the new Department of Transportation and to support its vital role in the improvement and maintenance of the good life we enjoy in our State.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
