WHEREAS, The Village Council of the Village of Keewatin, in the County of Itasca and State of Minnesota, is of the opinion that the population of said Village has increased to considerable extent since its last census was taken in the year 1920, and,

WHEREAS, Said Village Council deem it expedient and advisable that another census be taken at this time for the purpose of determining the exact population of said Village for the purpose of levying taxes therein, and in accordance with Chapter 417 of the Session Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year 1921, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Village Council of the Village of Keewatin, in the County of Itasca and State of Minnesota, at a regular meeting thereof, duly held at 8.00 o'clock P. M., on the 29th day of September, 1923, in the Village Hall of said Village, a quorum being present, that the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, be requested to take a census of the said Village of Keewatin, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4, of Chapter 417, of the Session Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year 1921.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Arthur Hall, Village Clerk, be, and he hereby is, directed and instructed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Honorable Mike Holm, Secretary of the State of Minnesota, together with a request that immediate action be taken thereon, in accordance with said Section 4 of Chapter 417, of the Session Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1921.
