WHEREAS: Key Club International, a high school service organization sponsored by Kiwanis International, is observing the week of November 14 - 20, 1976 as Key Club Week; and

WHEREAS: Key Club International in the United States is comprised of over 80,000 high school men; and

WHEREAS: the members of Coon Rapids Key Club are part of an International organization dedicated to serve with purpose, their God, country, state, and fellow man, seeking to give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life; and

WHEREAS: they promote the adoption of higher standards in school, community, and nation through a concerned citizenry; and

WHEREAS: through their purposeful service they have helped to build better communities where righteousness, justice, patriotism, and goodwill are more than just words; they become goals for living; and

WHEREAS: the current theme, "CHALLENGE TO INDIFFERENCE", involves programs of service, including pursuing better human relations and community betterment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 14 - 20, 1976 as
