Let us be thankful that our commitment to freedom, dignity and self-respect has been strengthened despite a succession of crises in our history which have seriously tested our national resolve and resiliency.

Let us be thankful that the deep religious beliefs on which the first Thanksgiving was founded are still part of the American tradition.

Let us pray that the love and wisdom of that "divine Providence" on which the signers of the Declaration of Independence placed their "firm reliance" will continue to guide the deliberations and decisions of our society.
