WHEREAS: on December 1, 1976, the Civil Air Patrol, Civilian Auxiliary of the United States Air Force, celebrates its 35th anniversary of service to the people of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Wing, Civil Air Patrol, has given good and valuable assistance to the people of the State of Minnesota in time of disaster or other peril; and
