IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION BY THE HONORABLE BENJAMIN F. GRUSSENDORF, JUDGE OF DISTRICT COURT, NINTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT, STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT ON JUNE 30, 1978, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF M.S. 490.124, SUBD. 8 AND 490.102, SUBD. 3a, AND FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF THE SAID HONORABLE BENJAMIN F. GRUSSENDORF UP TO AND INCLUDING JANUARY 30, 1978.

WHEREAS, M.S. 490.124, Subdivision 2, requires the Governor to make a written order accepting such retirement application and extending such term of office, and

WHEREAS, the necessary legal requirements have been met for such retirement and extension of term,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to M.S. 490.124, Subdivision 2, do hereby order that the present term of office for the said Honorable Benjamin F. Grussendorf be, and it hereby is, extended to and including January 30, 1978, and further order that retirement benefits pursuant to M.S. 490.124, Subdivision 8, computed on the basis of M.S. 490.102, Subdivision 3a, commence at the close of business on the day of January 30, 1978.
