

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION BY THE
HONORABLE BENJAMIN F. GRUSSENDORF, JUDGE
OF DISTRICT COURT, NINTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT,
STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT ON
? JUNE 30, 1978, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS
OF M.S. 490.124, SUBD. 8 AND 490.102,
SUBD. 3a, AND FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM
OF THE SAID HONORABLE BENJAMIN F. GRUSSEN-
DORF UP TO AND INCLUDING JANUARY 30, 1978.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Benjamin F. Grussendorf, having made appli-
cation to the said undersigned Governor Wendell R. Anderson, in a letter dated
June 21, 1976, for retirement pay of that portion of the maximum retirement
allowance allotted to his office which the years of his service bear to the
number of years required for the maximum retirement allowance of a district
court judge at the close of business on January 30, 1978, and for an extension
of his present term until said date, and

WHEREAS, the said Judge Benjamin F. Grussendorf will have served
continuously as said district court judge for ten (10) years, and

WHEREAS, M.S. 490.124, Subdivision 2, requires the Governor to make
a written order accepting such retirement application and extending such term
of office, and

WHEREAS, the necessary legal requirements have been met for such
retirement and extension of term,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, acting pursuant to M.S. 490.124, Subdivision 2, do hereby order that
the present term of office for the said Honorable Benjamin F. Grussendorf be,
and it hereby is, extended to and including January 30, 1978, and further order
that retirement benefits pursuant to M.S. 490.124, Subdivision 8, computed
on the basis of M.S. 490.102, Subdivision 3a, commence at the close of business
on the day of January 30, 1978.
