# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 1976

The City Council of the City of Luverne held its regular meeting in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 7:30 P.M. Tuesday, November 9, 1976. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Harold Deuschle, who presided.

# ROLL CALL:

On calling the roll, the secretary reported the following aldermen present: Dale Ahrendt, Vance Ebert, Gordon Gits and Jack Merrill. Absent: None. Also present was City Administrative Assistant Craig Osvog.

#### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

Motion by Ahrendt, seconded by Merrill to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of Tuesday, October 26, 1976 and the adjourned meeting of Monday, November 1, 1976. Roll Call of Votes: Ayes: Ahrendt, Ebert, Gits and Merrill. Nays: None. Absent: None. Carried.

# LIQUOR LICENSES:

Mr. Dick Teeslink was present and asked questions about the liquor licenses. The Council agreed that research should be done with regard to the fees, laws and legal requirements of the liquor licenses.

# **REPORTS:**

Motion by Merrill, seconded by Gits to approve the following reports and pay the claims contained therein. General - \$50,124.84, Utility -\$116,281.08, Liquor \$20,539.11. Roll Call of Votes: Ayes: Ahrendt, Ebert, Gits and Merrill. Nays: None. Absent: None. Carried.

Motion by Ahrendt, seconded by Ebert to approve the hospital report and pay the claims contained therein in the amount of \$86,029.53. Roll Call of Votes: Ayes: Ahrendt, Ebert, Gits and Merrill. Nays: None. Absent: None. Carried.

Motion by Gits, seconded by Ebert to approve the Fire Department Report of September 27, the Pool Commission Minutes of October 6 and November 3, the Police Report for September, the Planning and Zoning Commission Minutes of November 1, the Charter Commission Minutes of November 3 and the Library Minutes of November 3. Roll Call of Votes: Ayes: Ahrendt, Ebert, Gits and Merrill. Nays: None. Absent: None. Carried.

# VARIANCE REQUEST - PETERSON & ASSOCIATES:

Mr. Jim Peterson, representing Peterson & Associates, requested a variance to the parking requirements of the Zoning Ordinance. Their request was for 6.3 parking spaces per 1,000 square feet of floor area instead of the required 10 parking spaces per 1,000 square feet of floor area. Motion by Gits, seconded by Merrill to deny the request for the variance. Roll Call of Votes: Ayes: Ahrendt, Ebert, Gits and Merrill. Nays: None. Absent: None. Carried. The City Administrative Assistant was directed to research the parking requirements in other cities to determine the acceptability of the present requirements.

Mr. Randy Creeger was present at the meeting and addressed several questions to Mr. Peterson. Mr. Creeger expressed the concern that in the event the mall does become a reality that the Council take steps to insure that a good quality mall would be constructed.

Motion by Gits, seconded by Ebert that two easements on the property be moved if the project is approved. If the project is not approved the easements will remain where they are. The Mayor and City Administrative Assistant were authorized to enter into an agreement with the property owners whereby the easement on the lot line between Lots 2 and 3 would be relocated 60 feet to the South of and parallel to the existing easement and the easement located on the lot line between Lots 3 and 4 would be relocated 67 feet to the North of and parallel to the existing easement. #### MOVING PERMITS:

Motion by Ahrendt to approve the moving permit of Kenneth Beelmann. The motion died for lack of a second.

### LIBRARY BUDGET:

The Council discussed the Library Budget. Mr. Jim Kirchhofer was present to explain why the County reduced their library budget amount to \$22,472.00. The Council sgreed that the City will not change their budget amount of \$27,200.00 at this time.

# COST PROJECTION FOR PURCHASED POWER:

Figures were presented by the City Administrative Assistant to show the anticipated cost increases in purchase power. Comparison was made between the cost of power under the assumption that the present contract rate of delivery (9140 KW) would remain constant and under the assumption that the present contract rate of delivery would be reduced to 3889 KW. The projection showed that substantial cost increases would be forthcoming under the most favorable circumstances and also that the effect of a reduction in the contract rate of delivery would cause an increase of approximately \$500,000 in 1980 and \$900,000 in 1981.

### 1977 WAGE ADJUSTMENTS:

Discussion was had concerning the annual cost of living wage adjustment for 1977. A study by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics which determined the total effect of inflation on three income levels was discussed. It was determined that the annual cost of living adjustment would be given as an across the board percentage increase. Action was delayed in determining the percentage to be given in order to allow time to compute the exact total cost of the wage increase.
