ORDINANCE NO. 420

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of Thief River Falls ordains:

Section 1: Whereas all of the owners of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

A parcel of land which is part of Gov't. Lot 9, Section 35, Township 154 North, Range 43 West bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Northerly most corner of Lot 11 of Barnick's First Addition; thence Northeasterly along the Northwesterly line of said Lot 11 extended in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 100 feet; thence Southeasterly along a line parallel to the Northeasterly line of said Lot 11 to an intersection with the South line of said Section 35; thence West along said Section line to an intersection with the Northeasterly line of said Lot 11 extended; thence Northwesterly along said Northeasterly line of Lot 11 to the point of beginning; containing 1 acre more or less,

have petitioned to the City Council to have such land included within the City Limits of the City of Thief River Falls and have filed copies of said Petition with the Municipal Board of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of the Township of North of the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota and with the County Board of the County of Pennington, State of Minnesota and

Whereas the above described property abuts upon the boundaries of the City of Thief River Falls and

Whereas no objections to the proposed annexation have been submitted,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby determined that the annexation of said premises will be to the best interests of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are hereby declared

annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of North Township, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
