WHEREAS: *it is appropriate that we pause to recognize the many fine contributions made to the welfare of Minnesota's children and youth by professional school nurses and health service staffs working within the school environment; and*

WHEREAS: *these nurses and health service staffs also serve the community, state and nation in providing full and varied health services; and*

WHEREAS: *we share the nation's pride in their tireless leadership, service and competence;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 26, 1977 to be

MINNESOTA SCHOOL NURSE DAY

and January 23 - 29, 1977 to be

SHAPE (School Health - A Positive Environment) WEEK

sponsored by the School Nurses Organization of Minnesota, associated with the Minnesota Education Association.

FURTHERMORE, I urge all residents, all education associations, all news media and other community organizations to join in this salute by encouraging and promoting the goals of professional school nurses and their staffs as they contribute daily to the health and well-being of our nation.
